

HAITIANS PLEAD FOR HELP FOR STREET CHILDREN

GET INVOLVED

Manassas, Virginia- January 23, 2010 - The Missionaries of Our Lady of Divine Mercy worked late into the evening to prepare for the upcoming mission trip to Haiti. During one phone call to Port au Prince, a man pleaded for help for the children. He said, "There have always been street children, but now there are tens of thousands. Please help us build a "tent city" for these kids so they don't have to roam the streets at night."

Most of these children are searching for food, looting stores and houses just to survive.

IMMEDIATE RELIEF

The priority for the Missionaries will be to distribute medical supplies to area hospitals and deliver food to the local orphanages and street children. We will also be giving direct financial support to the orphanages, hospitals and Catholic Church which was devastated during the earthquake.
