Through our tears we smile for all of the blessings he shared with others and for the legacy he has left us.

The House of Mercy will continue to move forward carrying the vision and compassion Father Jack had for souls. He knew the House of Mercy was growing and he beamed with joy knowing that the message of mercy was spreading beyond our borders. *Now, we have outgrown our current home and have found a larger location which will help us not only continue to meet the needs of the underprivileged, but expand our programs as well.*

Effective October 1, 2010, we will move to our new House of Mercy. It is located on 8170 Flannery Court, Manassas, Virginia 20109 (It is right next to the Merrifield Garden Center on Wellington Road). The House of Mercy will be a destination for all who are seeking hope. It will be an active place of mercy and will have new hours from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, giving everyone an opportunity to serve or receive aid.

Here are just a few of the exciting programs we will have at our new location:

- Food Pantry
- Meal Packing for our community, Cote d'Ivoire, and Haiti
- Catholic Library
- Financial Assistance for shelter, medicine, funeral, or utilities
- New shoes for children in our Passport to Hope program
- Free clothes for the poor
- Thrift Store (we will be accepting everything from furniture to household items)
- Spiritual and Educational formation classes
- After-school reading programs for children
- Divine Mercy conferences
- Christmas with Mercy program for poor children
- Large indoor replica of Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto

The new House of Mercy was one of the dreams Father Jack had. He also prayed to build an orphanage in the Cote d'Ivoire. We are in union with his prayers and the reality of these locations begins in our own community, in our own neighborhood. It begins with people like you and me who understand that mercy is shared one soul at a time. God just uses us as the instruments.

We can't do this without you. We are personally asking each one of you to join us in honoring Father Jack's memory and continuing his mission of mercy. Please consider donating to our ministry regularly to help ensure that every child is served who passes through our doors. God speaks to us in many ways—sometimes through the whispers of a child.
